



Regulations for the use of the natural monument and National Geotope Partnachklamm

1. General

The market of Garmisch-Partenkirchen makes the National Geotope Partnachklamm available to the public for viewing against payment. There is no entitlement to admission to the gorge.

2. Admission prices / tickets

The current admission prices are published on a separate notice board. The visitor receives an entrance ticket against payment of the current tariff price. The one-way ticket entitles the holder to pass through the Partnachklamm gorge only on one day of purchase (1x in each direction). The ticket must be shown to the staff upon request. Redeemed tickets will not be taken back. If tickets are purchased for other visitors on their behalf, the purchaser confirms the applicable power of representation with the purchase and agrees to the validity of these usage regulations also on behalf of the visitors represented by him. There is no right to cancellation or exchange for tickets purchased in advance (including online tickets). The store reserves the right not to offer all services at the vending machines that are available at the counter. This does not give rise to a claim for reimbursement.

3. Opening hours

The Partnachklamm is open daily, from October - May from 08.00 - 18.00 and June - September from 08.00 - 20.00. The last admission to the gorge is 30 minutes before closing time. Outside the opening hours the stay and passage is prohibited for safety and nature protection reasons. The times when the gorge is closed for the annual revision or due to damage or work will be announced in each case with a separate notice, in the usual media and on the website www.parnachklamm.de. Short-term closures of the gorge are sometimes unavoidable for safety reasons. In the case of special events or instructions from the authorities (e.g. pandemic situation), the opening hours or the direction of passage through the gorge can be changed at short notice. If possible, this will be announced in good time in the media and on notice boards.

4. Rules of passage and use

When passing through the gorge and using the surrounding hiking trails, everyone must behave in such a way that no one else is endangered, harmed or obstructed or inconvenienced more than is unavoidable under the circumstances. The nature conservation regulations are to be observed without exception. In case of violation of these rules a special fee of 25,- EUR / person can be charged. Sturdy footwear with an appropriate tread must be worn. Furthermore, attention must be paid to rocky outcrops and low heights.

In particular, it is forbidden:

- To carry out torchlight hikes without permission.
- Ice climbing, canyoning or making fire in an area of 400 m in front of and behind as well as in the gorge.
- Littering or littering the area.
- Throwing objects down from the bridges.
- Canoes, bicycles, strollers, wheelchairs and similar bulky objects through the gorge or on the immediate access routes to carry this also applies to foldable models. When using Kraxen, attention must be paid to the heights. In individual cases, the use of umbrellas, so-called selfie sticks, photo tripods, etc. may be prohibited by our staff for safety reasons.
- To leave the given paths or to navigate the Partnach with aids (e.g. boats, rubber hoses or similar).
- To cross the gorge under the influence of alcohol or other intoxicating substances.
- To produce unnecessary noise (nature conservation) or to use so-called flying drones or other flying devices.
- Commercial film / photo / sound recordings require special permission, which must be obtained in advance in good time from the market. A claim to the granting of permission does not exist.

Further, please note:

- Dogs must be kept on a leash. Any soiling caused must be removed immediately by the person responsible for the animal. In individual cases and without giving reasons, the market reserves the right to refuse passage through the gorge to persons with dogs.
- Wheelchair users are not allowed to pass through the gorge and people with handicaps are not allowed to use the gorge, e.g. with rollators, due to the cramped conditions.
- Smaller children or people with special handicaps should be led by the hand of the respective accompanying person during the passage.
- In case of overcrowding, the gorge can be closed for a short time.
- The market provides a free parking space for bicycles at the northern entrance (new ticket office). Illegally parked bicycles (e.g. on the access roads) will be removed by the Klamm staff and parked in the bicycle parking area.

5. Domiciliary rights

The market Garmisch-Partenkirchen exercises the domiciliary rights on the area of the gorge and the access roads to the Partnachklamm. Instructions from the cashier or other employees of the market Garmisch-Partenkirchen are to be followed immediately. In case of gross or repeated violations, a ban can be imposed and future entry into the Partnachklamm can be prohibited (house ban). In addition, the market reserves the right to file a complaint with the police if necessary.

6 Liability

Despite all safety measures, due to natural conditions, certain dangers, such as falling rocks, ice, slipping, falling, etc. and therefore an increased risk of accidents and injuries with possible dangers to life and limb cannot be completely prevented. All visitors and guests must be aware of these dangers and risks and traverse the Partnachklamm at their own risk.

The market shall only be liable for damage to property insofar as this is based on a breach of an essential contractual obligation or on intentional or grossly negligent conduct by the market, one of its legal representatives or vicarious agents. If an essential contractual obligation is breached due to slight negligence, the liability of the market shall be limited to the foreseeable damage typical for the contract. An essential contractual obligation shall be deemed to exist if its fulfillment makes the proper execution of the contract possible in the first place or if the contractual partner has relied and was entitled to rely on its fulfillment.
